

Fairy lights are the ultimate **romantic** addition you could have to your wedding. Their warm white light is the epitome of romantic lighting.













Fairy Lights Hanging Applications





The most common way to use fairy lights is in a vertical layout. They can be used to form a backdrop or to cover a large vertical surface (such as walls).



For more sophisticated applications, the fairy lights can also be airborne, creating an "invisible ceiling" over the space they are mounted.



Whether in horizontal (suspended) or vertical layout, fairy lights are being supported with special mounts at almost any point (trees, railings, awnings, columns, frames, etc.). In case the wedding venue does not have existing points of mountings that we can use, we can provide our own. So the possibilities are literally endless.











Suspended Fairy Lights Applications

The horizontal layout of the fairy lights is achieved by spreading the lights in straight lines starting at one point and ending at another. By using many lines we achieve the well known «fairy tale» effect where the sky is filled with countless tiny lamps. The arrangement can be either symmetrical (following a specific design with equal spacing between the lines) or more abstract depending on the result we wish to achieve. 100,000 - 1,000 - 1,000 per reservant of the reservant of the second of

In a vertical layout, the Fairy Lights can also take the place of a curtain or partition. This application can also be done on walls, curtains, partitions or anywhere else. They can also work as a beautiful backdrop for the bridal table, the buffet or the table of wishes.
